STRATEGY TO PROTECT YOURSELF FROM CROSS VIRUS INFRASTRUCTORS IN THE WATER SUPPORT AND TRANSPORT SECTOR

The Tanzania Maritime Training Fund instructs all service providers in the transport and water transport sector and students in general to put in place strategies to combat the Corona virus infection.

All service providers including shipping and shipping holders, port service providers, Marine College trainers, students, shipping agents and cargo holders at ports are instructed to implement the following:

1. Owners of vessels should spray antiviral drugs in their vessels at the end of each voyage.
2. All crew and passengers entering and leaving the vessels, including ships, canoes and ferries, should wash their hands with running water and soap.
3. Consider the number of passengers allowed on the vessels when traveling from one area to another to avoid congestion.
4. Install hand washing equipment in the offices of port service providers, shipping agencies, inspectors and port carriers in the country.
5. Ensure that the precautionary measures against the Corona virus are provided within the means of transport by means of radios and televisions on such vessels.

The Tanzania Maritime Training Fund will oversee the implementation of these directives as part of the implementation of its responsibilities for the management of services for students in the Maritime sector.
